Call for proposals

We are seeking unmet clinical needs from clinician teams that are amenable to technological solutions. With our partner MIMIT™, Central Manchester University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (CMFT) is launching a new (annual) CMFT Clinical Need Award.¹
